
This expert database of scholars working on issues related to democracy and populism (https://bit.ly/2JcchSk) is part of the Jean Monnet Project "Canada-Europe Dialogues on Democracy: Democratic deficit and the rise of populism in Europe" (CEDoD), co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union and the Centre for Global Studies (2018-2020). It was carried out under the umbrella of the EUCAnet.org initiative at the University of Victoria.



The Dialogue on Democracy Research Group section of the database is embedded in the larger Europe Canada Network expert database that is hosted at the Centre for Global Studies (University of Victoria). The database connects scholars with multidisciplinary expert groups working on European Union, European Integration and issues of European affairs often from a comparative perspective.
