The Dialogue on Democracy Research Group section of the database is embedded in the larger Europe Canada Network expert database that is hosted at the Centre for Global Studies (University of Victoria). Currently, the CEDoD database includes scholars from across Canada, Europe, and the United States. The comprehensive search functions allow finding experts by name, discipline, field of expertise, academic institution, city, and country.
