Canada-Europe Dialogues on Migration

The current refugee crisis sheds light on some fundamental social and political challenges that are shared between Canada and the EU. In terms of advancing transatlantic dialogue and promoting EU Studies in Canada, the project Canada Europe Dialogue on Migration (CEDoM) brought together multi-disciplinary research groups on the issues of governance of borders and migration and instigate exchange between Canada and the EU in scholarly and broader public debates. A series of knowledge dissemination initiatives and engagement strategies targeted the public, policy stakeholders and civil society organizations allowing to promote the knowledge of European integration through the lens of migration and border studies in Canada.


